***It is important to note that the species listed are deer *resistant* not deer-proof. Deer are likely to sample anything as they move through your yard. Some tree and shrub species may not be harmed, in fact may benefit from periodic trimming done by deer. It is important to realize, however, that newly planted trees or shrubs are especially vulnerable and steps may need to be taken protect them until they are more mature.
